1. Enter P98950 in Fastpath.

2. Enter the User ID of the person who has the Custom Grid/Query that needs to be published to others. Enter the Object/Program in the Application QBE and click Find.

3. Version can be entered in the Version QBE to narrow down the results, or the correct Version can just be selected from all results. Queries are “UO Type” AQ and have a UO Description of the title of the Query. Grids are “UO Type” GF. For Grids, there is one line per version which includes all grid formats for that version. Users will have to delete any grids they do not want from the group published to them.

8. Log out. Wait 3-5 minutes. Ask User(s) to logout and log back in to JDE to view the published Custom Grid/Query.

There is no way to make the Custom Grid or Query the “default” for the user. They need to do that themselves.

Any changes that they make to grids, queries or groups of grids after publishing, will remain and become their new override in P98950.
